
A Word From the Associate Member Chair, Pat Pinkney:

Chronicle Editor's report (Mailings in March, May, June, July, August, and October):

• The next mailing is scheduled to go out in January that will have the approved 2015 budget. This will also include swim team sign ups and applications. The next mailing will be in March.

Rental Report:

• Brad reported rentals have been going well. Nothing new has been broken. A few more tables need to be purchased.

Pool Manager's report:

Swim Team Report:

• The Swim Team has hired a coach.

Associate Membership Chairperson:

• Pat reported mailings are ready to go out for the Associate Memberships.

Facility Report:

- CH Construction, Carl Henn, attended the Board meeting to go over a presentation for the possible remodel of the Clubhouse bathrooms.
 - Need plans developed due to the probability of losing a stall in both bathrooms. This will require an architect to draw up plans for the city. \$4,500 to present plans and get us to the permit process. A copy of the bid for this portion is an attachment to these minutes. A rough estimate for doing both bathrooms is from 40-60 thousand dollars. The work will be 3-4 weeks to be completed. The matter was tabled for later discussion.

Old business:

• The owners of the home at 4034 Forestwood Drive responded to our letter regarding their renters. They asked for a 2nd chance for the renters after having a conversation with them. Brad provided them with some additional information regarding the renters which happened since the letter was sent to them (the results of a probation search by Adult Probation and the Sheriff's Office at the residence.) With the additional information, the owners have notified the renters they will be evicted.

New business:

• We need a new pool vacuum. The old one is broken and cannot be repaired. Brad has requested a quote from the vendor. Once the quote is received, Brad will e-mail it for a vote.

Adjournment:

The meeting was adjourned at 9:37 p.m.
