


Note From Our Associate Membership Chairperson, Denelle Fedor





The two sisters spent time diligently preparing for the Advanced Green Belt test which is one of the hardest tests to take. The test consists of performing 2 advanced katas, Heian Yondan and Heian Godan, as well as executing 15 self defense grabbing techniques which include front and back chokes and hand grabs. The sisters had to demonstrate that they were able to quickly defend themselves from all positions of a grab attack. They also had to take a 5 page written test. Last but not least, they had to break 1-inch wooden boards using 2 hand strikes, 1 elbow strike and 1 kick.

Creeside 4th Of July Parade 2019






