What is a Swim-a-Thon?

CREEKSIDE CUDAS SWIM-A-THON FUNDRAISER

A Swim-a-Thon is a fundraiser where swimmers ask for sponsors to donate to their team for swimming a certain number of laps to be completed within a given time period.

How do I go about showing my support by helping a swimmer with a donation?

If a swimmer comes knocking on your door asking for a donation for Creekside's Swim-A-Thon, then you can show your support by donating **a flat fee or a per lap fee**. If a per lap fee, swimmers will multiply the per lap fees by the number of laps completed to attain the total donation amount from that sponsor. All flat fees are collected immediately, whereas per lap fees can be turned in by the deadline once the event is completed. Either way, know that the swimmer is going to swim laps from 5 pm to 9 pm and **all proceeds go directly to the swim team!**



Reading of the Minutes:

• The minutes for the January 2016 Board Meeting were unanimously approved by a vote of the Board.

Treasurer's report:

• The January 2016 and February 2016 financial reports was reviewed and approved by the Board.

Chronicle Editor's report (Mailings in March, May, June, July, August, and October):

• The next mailing will be in March.

Rental Report:

- The Clubhouse is booked all Saturdays up to August already. A lot of Sundays are still available for rental.
- Charles, our janitor, stripped and re-sealed the floor of the clubhouse.
- A renter complained about the cleanliness of the floor upon her arrival for a rental. Shelley gave the renter the option to have her husband, Pancho, mop the floor for them or to call the previous renter back to mop. The renter stated she had time to wait, and said she was fine with the previous renter coming back to mop. Shelley contacted the previous renter and the previous renter returned and re-mopped the floor. After the party, the renter asked for a discount due to waiting for the floor to be mopped. After discussion the Board voted not to give a discount based on the renter being okay with the delay for the floor being re-mopped.

Pool Manager's report:

- Staff has been hired. An orientation for staff meeting was held on Saturday, March 12, 2016.
- A clean up day is scheduled for March 19, 2016.

Swim Team Report:

- The Swim Team has a new website. The site allows for on line registration and accepts credit cards.
- 123 swimmers have signed up so far.
- The Wine and Pasta Social is May 14, 2016 as a fundraiser. All in the community are welcome to attend. There will be wine for sale at the event by Brazone Winery. Buyers may go in with each other to purchase cases of wine.

Facility Report:

- The baby pool was priced out for re-plastering. The bids all came in around \$6,000. Considering the price of this, we are now looking at painting the pool instead. Brad is researching how to complete the project.
- The facility is in need of members who can work on a few projects. We need to have planters rebuilt and fences mended.
- The BBQ grates were placed in plastic wrap. Someone pushed them out into the rain and let them sit in a bucket to rust. We now need new BBQ grates for the season.
- Renters have been using the Swim Team BBQs. They need to be moved away from the rental area to avoid the renters using them.
- The doors need to be replaced for the Racing Pool pump room.
- Purchasing picnic tables for baby pool play area will be voted on via future e-mail as the options Shawn presented were not liked by the Board.

Old business:

• None discussed.

New business:

• An umbrellas insurance policy for the cabana club is due. Sharon e-mailed us two policies to choose for coverage for the Association. The Board voted to approve an insurance policy from Traveler's Insurance for liability and CNA for the Directors and Officers liability insurance for a total of \$11,855. This is a savings over last year.

Adjournment:

The meeting was adjourned at 9 p.m.
