Day in The Park Festival: October 1, 10am – 3pm @ Lake Cunningham Regional Park

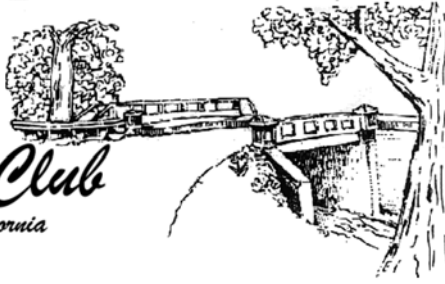
