HELP SAVE OUR EVERGREEN SCHOOLS!

As many of you know, due to a decline in student enrollment, Evergreen School District may be closing 1-2 schools in the Central West region. The schools being considered for this are Laurelwood, Cadwallader, Dove Hill, Montgomery and JFS. Recently, many of you also signed a petition and participated in a survey posted on Nextdoor so for that we say "Thank You" as it shows the FAC (Facilities Advisory Committee) and School Board that we have a voice and will be heard! Thanks to Mylinh Chan who put countless hours into coming up with alternative proposals. These solid ideas about how to attract students to stay in public schools, specifically in our district, instead of going to private or charter schools have been submitted. There will be two public meetings in March where the FAC will be speaking to the public and which will be open for public comment. Over 60 people attended the last school board meeting and 12 people spoke out about the potential school closures (repurposing) which got the trustee's attention. It let them know that the residents will not sit back and let this happen. If you are a concerned citizen, please consider attending one or both of these meetings. The first is tentatively scheduled for March 14, 2017 at Montgomery School from 6:30pm-8pm and the second is tentively scheduled for **March 24, 2017** at Levva Middle School from 6:30pm-8pm. Not only will potential closures of these schools effect those of us who have children but also the property values for those of us who do not if they allow it to be vacant for a while or turn it into a continuation school. They want to use the school for revenue generation rather then to protect our neighborhoods by doing such things as opening up Yerba Buena Ave to Yerba Buena Rd. again when we already have problems with people racing up and down our street. Closure is not in effect for another couple of years but they have other options to take like repurposing the vacant land on San Felipe. A decision will not be finalized until April so we still have time to make our voices heard!



2017 SHARKS CITY NATIONALS Karate Tournament

The annual Sharks City Nationals were held in San Jose in February. Over 60 competitors from the Dragon Cloud Dojo competed in this prestigious event!

Many of our beginner and intermediate students participated in Forms (KATA) in this year's tournament in the "First-Timer" division. This division gets the student ready for "Regular" divisions. All students worked hard during the month of January to prepare for this tournament. There are rules and protocol when they compete. The rings have 3 judges who score each person after they complete their kata. The student must bow into the ring, walk up to the judges, tell them their name as well as the kata they will be performing, and lastly ask permission to begin their Form. The student then backs up in the ring, bows, and starts their Form. The judges are looking for power, sequencing, stances, movement, and attitude. We also had some of our White belts along with our Yellow belts compete in Point-Fighting (KUMITE) at the tournament which resulted in taking home 2


metals for their divisions! Lastly, some of our intermediate and advanced students competed in Weapons (KOBUDO) as well as in Point-Fighting in this year's tournament.

At the conclusion of the tournament, Dragon Cloud Creekside was awarded the "Most Supportive School" which was a great honor. Dragon Cloud Creekside has always been very competitive. Every year, students showcase their tremendous amount of skill by participating in karate tournaments as well as competing with students from many schools from all over the greater Bay Area.
