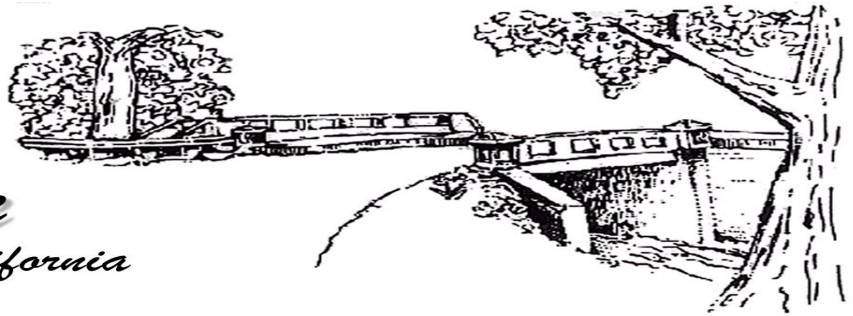

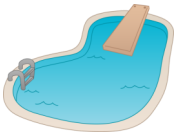

The April 13th School Board Meeting at Laurelwood Elementary School saw a completely packed audience due to the Facilities Advisory Committee report which suggested closing two schools would be the best way to help keep the EESD budget intact. Unfortunately for them, the community came out in full force by responding with their anger at closing these neighborhood schools. Near and dear to the hearts of Creeksiders were first Cadwallader as a potential target which later changed to Laurelwood. What will happen to our neighborhood if this school closes? What type of revenue generating business could find a home there which could benefit both the school district and the neighborhood? The Board of Trustees voted to accept the report without committing to any action at this time. The fight is not over to save our schools. Please continue to show your support by coming to the board meetings and sending your ideas to the Trustees. Thankfully, most of the Trustees are committed to doing what is best for our children and our community. Lets help them figure out the best way to keep all of our neighborhood schools operating!

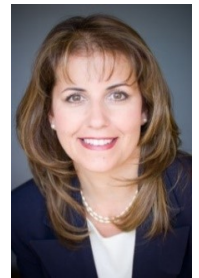

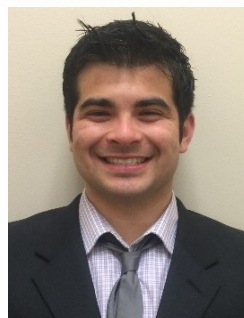

Several dedicated students practiced intently for 2 spring karate tournaments held in March and April, the "Mokomoko Championships" and the "Victory Games Championships".

Competition is just one of the aspects of Martial Arts. You must be mentally and physically strong to compete against any opponent that comes from the greater Bay Area. These students practice very hard to do their best at these world class tournaments.

In the Kata (forms) division, the student must present themselves properly to the judges, as well as perform their Kata with power and accuracy of sequence. Forms are a series of moves that simulates fighting an opponent in combat. Even the students attitude is assessed. In the Kumite (fighting) division, the student practices point-fighting. Points are awarded for punches, kicks, and hand strikes to the head in advanced divisions. The target is center body, chest and head level. This division is always difficult because the competitor comes to the tournament not knowing who will be his opponent that day. Fighting your fellow students in the Dojo is much different than facing an opponent you know nothing about. The lesson is to be able to defend yourself under any circumstance. What is a Swim-a-Thon?

A Swim-a-Thon is a fundraiser where swimmers ask for sponsors to donate to their team for swimming a certain number of laps to be completed within a given time period.

How do I go about showing my support by helping a swimmer with a donation?

If a swimmer comes knocking on your door asking for a donation for Creekside's Swim-A-Thon, then you can show your support by donating a **flat fee** or a **per lap fee**. If a per lap fee, swimmers will multiply the per lap fees by the number of laps completed to attain the total donation amount from that sponsor. All flat fees are collected immediately, whereas per lap fees can be turned in by the deadline once the event is completed. Either way, know that the swimmer is going to swim laps from 5 pm to 9 pm and **all proceeds go directly to the swim team!**

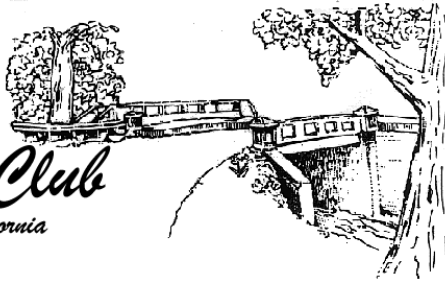
