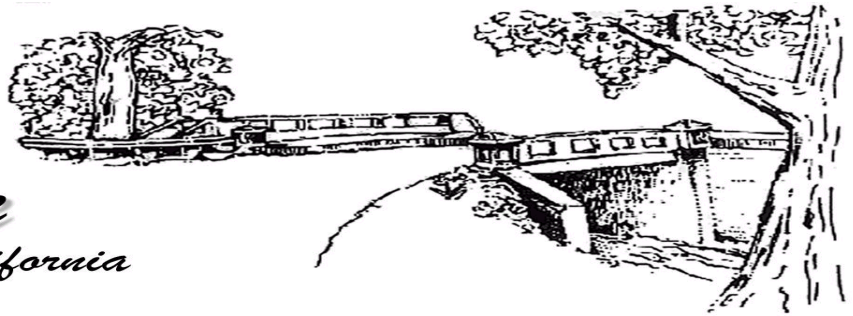

In Loving Memory of Carolyn Clark



Carolyn Clark was one of the two longest serving school board trustees for the Evergreen School District and many feel she shaped the culture of Evergreen. She and her husband Dallas, were original owners in our own Creekside Neighborhood, purchasing their home in 1966.

Many of us got to know the Clark family through the annual Halloween Haunted House that they set up in their front yard every year. What started out sometime in the mid 70's from scaring kids and passing out candy from their front porch, turned into a full blown haunted house that literally attracted over a thousand people each October for 40 years!

Carolyn Clark was a native of San Jose, attended public school, and was a cheerleader at James Lick High School. It was during her years at James Lick that she met the love of her life, Dallas Clark. She eventually married and had 3 wonderful children, Stacey, Lori, and Michael. Dallas and Carolyn began their family business, Dallas Sheet Metal Manufacturing, in their garage, and eventually moved to their permanent location in Santa Clara. This business supported them for over 42 years.

While Carolyn was never a classroom teacher, once her children started school, she unknowingly embarked on a pursuit that would fill her life advocating for children and education in Evergreen. Early on she juggled working at the family business, raising her children, and volunteering at Cadwallader Elementary where her kids attended school. When her eldest daughter, Stacey, was 12 years old, Carolyn ran for the EESD School Board and retained that seat for 35 years. She advocated for special education, strong academic curriculum and support for teachers in the district. During her tenure, she helped expand the district from 8 to 18 schools. The district recognized her efforts by opening the Carolyn A. Clark Elementary School in 2004. Carolyn loved children and took great delight in her 9 grandchildren. Five of the nine (Katie and Ethan Clark, and Justin, Jordan and Joshua Gaspar) graduated from their grandmother's school!

Carolyn was a remarkable woman. A quote from her daughter Lori "I wish I had truly understood the magnitude of her existence before she passed. I guess one never knows the true impact of our being here on earth." It is for others to see, feel and hopefully be inspired by someone such as Carolyn. She is loved, missed, and remembered daily because of who she was and what she stood for. Rest in peace Carolyn Clark.
