The swim season is officially under way! We had new beginner tryouts a few weeks ago and we are so excited to announce that we gained 9 new Cudas not including the 5 new Cudas from winter conditioning! I would personally like to say 'Congratulations and welcome to the Cuda family' to all of our new swimmers. Our team is already working so hard to prepare for this season. Right now, we are breaking down our strokes and focusing on our technique and turns. This year with our focus being on 'Race Planning', we will really be working on fast and strong finishes for our 10 and under swimmers swimming 25s. For our 11 and up swimmers, our main focus will be swimming 50s flip turns as well as open turns. Our coaching staff wants to see our team plan out each race and know exactly how to attack it! So far after only a few weeks of being in the water, I think that we are already looking good and are on track to have another great season! So much improvement in so little time tells me we are off to a really great start and I can't wait to see what the rest of the season holds for us!

# The SHARK CITY NATIONALS Karate Tournament

The prestigious SHARK CITY NATIONALS Karate tournament was held in San Jose on March 16<sup>th</sup>. The Dragon Cloud Dojo at Creekside came out in full force that day to compete in Kata (forms), Kumite (fighting) and Kobudo (weaponry). Some students are now competing in more than one division which takes a lot of skill and dedication in their training.

Competition is just another aspect of training. Competitors train in their forms, to get better in their stances, punches, kicks, handstrikes, power and attitude to perform in front of spectators and 3 official judges who score each competitor. Point-fighters hone their skills in the dojo each week as well by sparring with each other to make progress in getting quicker with their punches and kicks as they work on being "first" to hit the point target area on the opponent's body. Our weapons competitors practice maneuvering their specific weapon over and over whether it be with the Bo Staff, the Kama's or the Sai's. Students work on form as they simulate fighting with an opponent who is empty handed or has a weapon in hand as well. There are also rules and traditions that are learned and followed. Respect is Dragon Cloud's number one "Rule of Training". Respectfulness is always shown to parents, other competitors, as well as judges, officials, and all martial arts instructors.

Sensei James and Deborah are so very proud of these dedicated students. The Dragon Cloud School was awarded a beautiful marble trophy cup for "The Most Supportive School" that day as well! Congratulations to Dragon Cloud School as well as to all the competitors for a job well done!
