We do this to ensure that we are providing you, our members and guests, with a fun and safe environment this season. We are open weekends in May from 12 noon until 7 pm so we hope that you are ready to come and enjoy the sun in our relaxing shaded grass area or take a dip in the pool! Also, the Cabana Club is a great place to host your next summer pool party. Get a head start by reviewing and filling out the barbeque and picnic area reservation form which can be found on our website at creeksidecabanaclub.com and then bring the filled out form directly to the Cabana Club anytime from May 4th on so that one of our staff members can help you to complete the process of booking your pool party. 

What is a Swim-a-Thon?

A Swim-a-Thon is a fundraiser whereby swimmers earn money for the team by swimming laps within a given period of time. They do this by asking sponsors, whether it be family, friends, neighbors or businesses, to pledge a certain amount of money per lap or to make a flat donation in support of the team. All proceeds are used towards needed equipment for the swimmers such as kick boards etc. as well as needed pool equipment such as lane lines, covers, flags, and blocks.

How do I go about showing my support by helping a swimmer with a donation?

If a swimmer comes knocking on your door asking for a donation for Creekside's Swim-A-Thon, then you can show your support by donating a flat fee or by pledging a per lap fee. All flat fees are collected immediately, whereas per lap fees can be turned in by the deadline once the event is completed and the swimmer has had a chance to calculate the total donation amount based on the number of laps completed. Eight dedicated students studied and took their tests to move on to the next level of training. These students had to take an oral and written test that covered material from the karate booklet as well as a physical test which included performing everything which they have learned so far. Four students, **JUSTIN**, **ARCHITA**, **EZIEKEL** and **LUKE** moved on to the rank of 5th Kyu Green Belts. These students have now moved on to the advanced class where they will start their weaponry training with the Bo staff. More techniques will be introduced as well at this level including learning 15 grabbing techniques along with reviewing their 15 striking techniques to get better in their self-defense skills.

Last but not least, **GIOVANNA** has been diligently practicing her testing material and has moved on to the rank of 4th Kyu Advanced Green Belt. This is one of the hardest tests as she had to take a 5 page written test, perform all her Katas (forms) along with executing 15 striking techniques quickly and efficiently. Last, she had to break a 1 inch piece of wood with 2 handstrikes, 1 elbow and 1 kick. Congratulations to Giovanna who broke all 4 boards! What a huge accomplishment!


