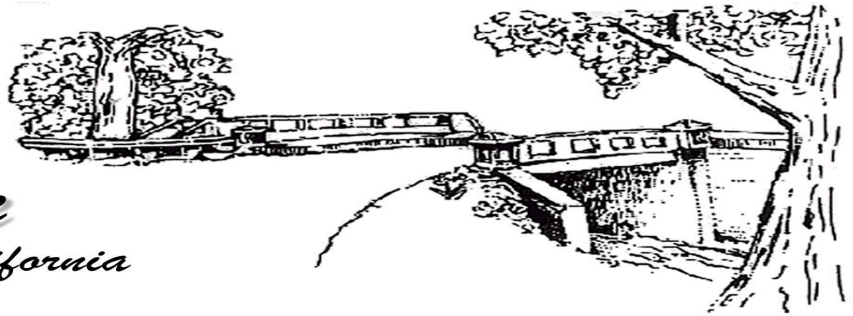

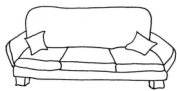

Do you have some old junk which you want to get rid of? As a San Jose resident, you can arrange to have large items such as mattresses, sofas, tires, refrigerators etc., anything that won't fit in your garbage or recycling bins, picked up by your recycling collection company **FOR FREE!**. You just have to go to the city's website at sjenvironment.org/largeitems and follow 4 basic steps. 1) Review the list of acceptable junk items 2) Enter your address in the Residential Services Lookup map to find your Recycling Company (they will pick up your junk for you) 3) Call the recycling company to schedule your appointment and have the list of items you are trying to get rid of ready 4) Set out your items up to 24 hours before your scheduled appointment. It's that EASY!

We Have A New Pool Manager! Meet Ivonne Luescher



Greetings Creekside Community! My name is Ivonne Luescher and I will be your new pool manager starting this season. I am originally from Colombia, South America but was raised in the San Jose area. In matter of fact, I even went to Silver Creek High School where I met my husband Eric and where he now works as a teacher. In 2002, my husband and I moved to Creekside with our two kids, Trevor and Hailey. I am very excited for this new challenge as pool manager since Creekside has been an awesome community to live in and be a part of for myself and my family. My daughter Hailey was part of the swim team from 2007 until last year when she graduated and has since gone onto college. My son Trevor, while not on the swim team, was an assistant manager at the Cabana Club a few years back. I also have had the privilege of being on the Board of Directors for over 10 years now where I am currently serving the role of Treasurer. Along with meeting some amazing people just by being on the board as well as interactions with other parents while

Hailey was on the swim team, I have seen first hand just how our pool and the Cabana Club has pulled the community together over the years! I love being involved in my community and hope to continue what the many fantastic managers before me have done to keep the Cabana Club the focal point in our community for people to meet their neighbors and where lasting memories are made for each and every family that passes through. With that said, while I have been a part of this community for a long time now, there are always new families joining our community so I look forward to meeting more of you as I take on my new role. I hope that you make sure to come by and enjoy the sun in our relaxing shaded grass area or to take a dip in the pool once it gets warm enough this summer when we open on Saturday, May 4th! We are currently in the process of hiring our staff for the 2019 season as well as preparing diligently for opening day. However, this doesn't mean that you have to wait to book your pool party! Simply go to our website at www.creeksidecabanaclub.com to review and fill out our barbeque and picnic area reservation form. Members can book picnic tables for parties up to 75 guests. Our first big event at the Cabana Club will be our annual Memorial Day festivities so mark your calendars. This year as has been offered in the past, we will be once again be offering our swim lessons starting June 3rd. There will be a total of 6 sessions being offered with the sixth one, from August 12th to August 22nd, being dependent on the availability of our staff. Each session is two weeks long and there are a total of 8 classes per session, Monday through Thursday, that are each 30 minutes in duration. If interested, please contact me, Ivonne, at creeksidecabanaclub@gmail.com. One friendly reminder though is that before you can register for swim lessons or come make use of the pool, you must be prepared to show that your dues have been paid and that your **2019 emergency form has been filled out**. You can find a copy of the 2019 emergency form on page 11 of this newsletter should you still need to fill one out. Feel free to bring the filled out 2019 emergency form with you on your first visit to the pool or mailing it to the Cabana Club ahead of time. Because we are also responsible for the safety of our members who frequent the Cabana Club, we must ensure that all lifeguards we hire are properly trained and certified to do their job. To accomplish this, we use a company called Happy Swimmers who come to the Cabana Club and conduct an intensive two day lifeguard certification class which usually takes place in April. Because this class is not taught directly through us, it is open to the public but you must register online at www.happyswimmers.com. We make sure that our lifeguards needing the class get signed up right away and then all remaining spots are open for the taking. If interested, go to the Happy Swimmers site noted above and then hit the lifeguard certification button where you will find a calendar with all the places classes are being held to register along with information such as cost, dates and times. All students who pass the two day course will be given a Red Cross certification in Lifeguarding, CPR, AED and Lifeguard First Aid upon successful completion of the class and which is typically valid for a total of two years. Finally, we will be having a **clean up day on Saturday, April 27th from 10am to 3pm** for anybody in the community who would like to help get the Cabana Club ready for the 2019 season! Any amount of time you may have available that day would be much appreciated to come by and volunteer to help prepare the club for what should be a fantastic season!

Because we live in such an awesome community, I encourage everybody to take advantage of our club as it is here for all of us to use and above all enjoy! I view it as a fun and relaxing place that many communities would be jealous of as there are not that many more around. I hope that you take the time to come by and introduce yourself on your visits to the Cabana Club as I am looking very forward to being your pool manager and in closing want to welcome everybody, both old and new, back to the pool this summer!

You should have received these two items along with a third, the Creekside Cabana Club Policy which is new this year, in either a bright yellow or green envelope. If you did not receive this for whatever reason, please make sure to contact me ASAP using my contact information below! The Associate Membership fee for the 2019 season is \$450 and is non-refundable. Payment was due in full by March 3, 2019 and your completed emergency form ***needed*** to accompany your membership check. We ask that you fill out a ***NEW*** emergency form for 2019 ***EVEN IF NOTHING HAS CHANGED FROM PRIOR YEARS!*** Also, remember that if you have children on the Cuda Swim Team, you are required to pay the \$450 Associate Membership fee with the only exception being if you live within the assessed HOA Creekside neighborhood. 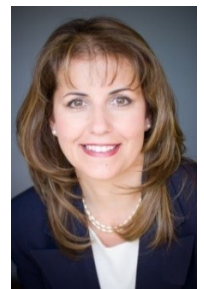

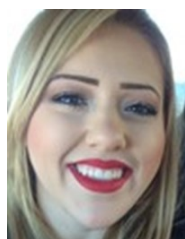
Message From Your Cuda Parent Reps

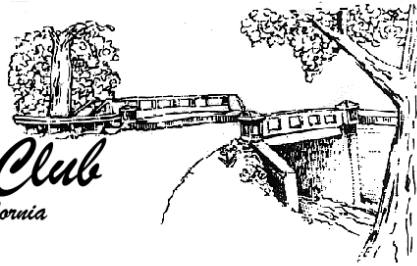

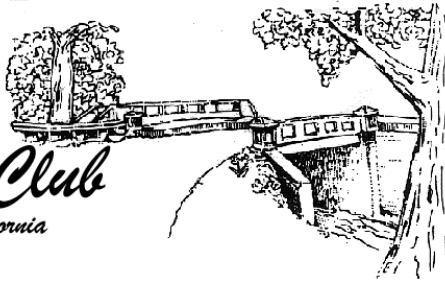
